Message from The Principal

Cross country was the big event for this week. It was great to see all of our children out participating in either our school cross country on the Taieri Schools Cross Country. A special well done to the 12 children who qualified for the Otago Championships in Cross Country. We will be giving out certificates today from these two events.

This week the Board of Trustees met for their regular meeting. At this meeting the Board selected a new member to join the Board of Trustees through until the next election, next year. We welcome Aaron Whitley to the Board. Aaron and Susie have 5 sons who have all attended Elmgrove over the years. Aaron has had a wide variety of experiences and will bring a strong set of skills and knowledge to our Board. We look forward to working with him and are confident he will be a strong addition to the team. Aaron has written a little more about himself and you will find this in todays newsletter.

This year the school has had a focus on Health and Wellbeing. As part of this we have completed the NZCER wellbeing survey with the children in Years 4 - 6 each term. The board received a report based on the results from the last two surveys and were able to discuss the positive improvement identified in many areas. We will also use this information to set goals moving further through the year. The Board will be conducting another survey with the staff later this term as part of our Wellbeing focus.

There was considerable time spent discussing the schools property projects which have been identified for the next 5 years. These include upgrades to the middle block, roof replacements, toilet upgrades and boiler replacements. These will need to be spaced out but will be significant school improvements completed over the next couple of years.

Finally the Board approved the updates to the schools Self Review policies which have been on the school website for the last 6 weeks.
