# Message from The Principal

School reports are in the process for being printed and will coming home with your children tomorrow all going well. School interviews are scheduled for next week on Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday. I see we have over 200 interviews already booked. If you have not yet booked an interview with your children's teachers I suggest you get in quickly and book one of the slots still available. Interviews can be booked at www.schoolinterviews.co.nz using the event code th454.

I remind parents that school closes for tuition at 12.30pm on the Tuesday so that interviews can begin at 1pm. We invite parents to collect their children early. Any children who are left at school will be supervised by teacher aides in a classroom. If you are picking your child up after 12.45 please let the teachers know via email so we know to look for your child and direct them to the supervision class.

At this stage there will be no after school care operating on this day. It will be running as normal but relocated to Room 1&2 on the Wednesday and Thursday. School will also operate as normal on the Wednesday and Thursday.

This week we have had The Food for Thought programme in the senior school. This was excellent and the students learned a lot about different foods. Some children even got a trip to the supermarket yesterday to practice reading food labels and identifying healthy foods.

The community pantry is open again and we are welcoming families to add what they can spare and take what they need. If you have any extra vegetables in your garden we are asking if you would consider putting them in our pantry, extra tin donations would also be appreciated. The food pantry is located on Ayr Street.

Assemblies are scheduled to start again next week. This will be our first child lead assembly in quite some time. The Rata Hub will be leading our first assembly on Friday next week.

We line the curtains of the main heat source room, the bedrooms of children and all the curtains in the house for people with severe health issues. The Dunedin Curtain Bank has been established since 2013 and in that time we have given over 3000 curtains.

With our work we also save up to 6 ton of fabric from landfill annually. We train youth machinists, students and volunteers to go back into the workforce.

We also have an ENVIROSHOP where we sell beautiful bags fashioned from vintage fabric/curtain

Thank you for helping us to inform our community and assisting in keeping people warm and healthy this winter.


