Message from The Principal

The first game of mini-ball was held this week. We have 5 teams competing in this competition, and the children were excited about their first game. We have created a new area on the school website dedicated to our school sports. On this page you will find all the information you need about the different sporting activities. We also have information about other one off, sporting activities such as the cross country, triathlon, swimming sports, athletics and other TSSA events. The next event being held is for the year 4 - 6 students who will be attending the TSSA orienteering event next Tuesday. While I am talking about how you can access information from the school, I want to again mention the Skool loop app. You need to have access to this app in order to book school interviews which are being held 22nd - 24th June. This week we have noticed a change in weather with the arrival of some good frosts. Please make sure you are careful walking or traveling to school in these winter conditions. Should school be required to close or start late any time during winter, due to ice or snow, we will notify parents via our facebook page and using the skool loop app. This information is also broadcast on local radio stations. Hopefully we will not have to use these measures.

With the arrival of winter conditions we also see an increase in the instances of cold and flu. Please be conscious of this and keep children who are unwell home to prevent the spread to others. Children who home with vomiting or diarrhoea should be kept home for 24 hours after they stop.

This will be done in June and will mean the driveway access to the school will be blocked off for a couple of days. Senior students will need to access the school via the carpark gate or through the office during this time. I will remind you of this closer to the time. It will be good to have the asphalt repairs completed and made safer for our scooting population.



Skool Loop is now going to be used to book in Parent Teacher interviews. All of our families will need this app to access the booking portal. Please follow the step by step guide below to download and activate the application in preparation for school interviews later this term.

Downloading the Skool Loop app - a step by step guide

- Download Skool Loop App, Via either your Google Play or App Store.
- Open the Skool Loop App you will land on a welcome page.
- Click the "Select your schools' this will bring you to a menu you can either search your school or follow the country/region prompts.
- Once you reach your school, select it with the tick on the righthand side.
- Tap the "select schools' button in the top right corner.
