We will share a link and Meeting ID via student email so that the students can join in our Zoom sessions. You do not need to have a Zoom account for this and we do **not** recommend that students create Zoom accounts.

You will then need to enter a Meeting ID and a password (we will share this with students prior to the meeting time).
