## Parent & Caregivers

*Your child has decided to work towards completing their Emerald PRIDE Homework Award. This means you need to help them to choose one task from each of the boxes below and support them to complete the task. They need to complete a total of eight tasks to gain this award.*

*Your child should talk to their teacher before they begin a task and will need to think about how to present their completed work. Remember the task is the important part.*

*Most importantly of all, spend time with your child on their selected tasks and have fun with them and their learning.*

### The Arts

- Learn a musical instrument for a year.
- Go to an Arts event (e.g. art exhibition, museum display, dance/drama performance, play, musical recital) and report back to the class on what you saw and heard.
- Choreograph a dance, jump jam routine or haka and present it to your class or syndicate.
- Design an Arts challenge of your own choice.



### Giving

- Give 5 - 7 random acts of kindness. Record what, when, how and for who.
- Prepare and serve a meal for others that includes veges you have grown yourself.
- Be involved in helping with a sausage sizzle or "Op Shop" stalls.
- Give 10% of your pocket money or earnings to a charity for a term.
- Design a giving challenging of your own choice.
- Get involved in an organised fundraiser like the 40 hour famine.



## Academic

- Present a report and photo to the class on a school or community event for publication in the school's newsletter or website.
- Read at least six chapter books in a term.
- Present a three minute speech to your class on a topic of your choice.
- Record and share orally, with a set of detailed instructions, how to make something.
- Design a challenge of your choice in a curriculum area.



## Service

- Prepare and cook a meal for your family with at least two courses.
- Find a part of your classroom that needs help and design and implement improvements.
- Give away some garden veges you have grown or cook a meal for a community member.
- Ask a teacher if you could help out a child in a certain curriculum area for one month.
- Design a Service challenge of your own choice.

## Physical Activity

- Organise and run a week long series of lunchtime activities.
- Write a unit plan for a teacher to teach the skills and rules of a sport you know well.
- Write 5 - 7 short brain breaks to teach the class.
- Go on an overnight tramp with a family member
- Design a Physical Activity challenge of your own choice.
