We will be conducting interviews later this week to find a new teacher for the Kowhai hub. Once this is done we will have our full contingent of teachers confirmed.

I remind parents that school finishes for the year at 12.30pm on Wednesday this week. This is an early pick up for all children and we do not have an after school care programme operating on this day.


