## **Message from The Principal**

Last night we had our annual Elmgrove's got talent show in the Taieri Performing Arts Centre. This is always a great event. It was great to see so many children wanting to take part and share their talents with the school and their wider whanau. With well over twenty items it was an entertainment filled evening. While there was lots of dance we also had a number of singers as well as guitar, ukulele and drum performances. Thank you to all of the children who found the courage to stand up in front of their peers and an audience of 300+ people to perform.

Last week we had the team from Downers at school talking with the children about the road works that are beginning outside our school. We expect this work to last well into the new year and so we took this opportunity for them to meet with our children and talk to them about safety around road works. They explained the different road signs and even bought in a digger for the children to look over. We know that the road works will cause some disruption to traffic flow over the coming months and we ask that you drive carefully watching out for our children who may be crossing in different places to normal.

Next week we have some contractors at school working on the re-surfacing in the front of the school. We are extending our artificial surface area to reduce the mud we get in wet weather. This project is being funded from both school funds and fundraising team efforts. During the second half of next week the front gate will be closed off to allow contractors to work in this area. Children will need to enter the school via the Argyle street vehicle gate or the Ayr street gate while this work is underway.

A reminder that our next and final teacher only day for this year is on Monday 20th November which is only a little over a week away. All schools will be taking a teacher only day within this week to undertake curriculum refresh work set out by the Ministry of Education. Please make sure you have noted this day and made other arrangements for your children as school will be closed.

Thank you to our 2nd year student teachers, Miss Perkins and Miss McCarthy, for your work in our school over the last three weeks. Today is their last day at Elmgrove. Our first year trainees will be here for one more week and we will farewell them next Friday. Our children always enjoy the opportunity to work with these teachers throughout the year and they are as real assets to have within our classrooms

Not long now until Christmas. I would like to take this opportunity to thank you all for supporting the KIDS WEST holiday program and would like to wish you and your families a very Merry Christmas and a Safe and Happy New Year.

We will NOT be running a program before Christmas as Elmgrove School finishes on Tuesday 19th December and we are getting new carpet laid in the hall at this time. There will be NO After School Care available on Tuesday 19th December.
