PLEASE TAKE THE TIME TO READ THIS NOTICE School Safety Improvements: Elmgrove School

The Dunedin City Council has contracted a package of School Safety Improvement work to Downer NZ Ltd.

You may be aware that the work involved at Elmgrove Primary School in Mosgiel includes a raised crossing at the school intersection improvements at the intersections of:

- Argyle Street and Mure Street
- Argyle Street and Ayr Street
- Argyle Street and Lanark Street

Stage one at Argyle and Lanark Streets is nearing completion. The next stage will include the intersection of Argyle and Mure Streets and the intersection of Argyle and Ayr Streets.

We are writing to let you know that, subject to weather and other unforeseen circumstances, we will be starting Stage 2 approximately Wednesday 29th November.

Stage Two: This stage of work will include a road closure on Argyle Street from Mure Street to Ayr Street, one way traffic on parts of Ayr and Mure Streets and temporary speed restrictions. Detours will be marked with detour signage so that you can still reach your destination.

School traffic will have vehicle access to Elmgrove School heading towards Hall Street and turning left into the school grounds. All vehicles departing the school onto Ayr Street will need to turn left and follow the detour signs.

Public bus stops affected by detoured routes will have temporary locations during the work.

Please note, we will use the feedback we receive to help with our planning and communication, but we will not be able to meet everyone's preferences.

Some notes about the work are below:

Safety - As construction work can create multiple hazard areas, please be aware of the dangers posed by machinery and work sites. Whilst we endeavour to leave the site as tidy and user-friendly as possible, please also be aware that the work area may have uneven surfaces and take care if you need to cross the site. Should you notice anything of concern on our operational sites, I welcome your feedback.

Road closure - Downer will have temporary road closures, detours, speed restrictions and other traffic management measure sin place during the work. If access is required during working hours, please liaise constructively with staff on-site or contact me to arrange this. **Please be assured that mail and rubbish services will be accommodated**.

Access and Parking – Prior to work commencing, we will place no-parking cones in the area we would like left clear to enable our work to be carried out. Please keep your vehicles clear from this area. Vehicles within our work site restricting our ability to carry out the work safely may be shifted.

During construction access to some properties may be restricted. This can be a couple of days while we excavate old kerb & pour new kerb, usually 3-5 days. If you have any concerns regarding access, please talk to crew onsite who can advise and work to enable access when required.

Disruption - We understand construction works can cause major disruption. We will be doing all we can to minimise the impact on your household or business.

Communication - Please note that resurfacing and construction work can be subject to weather. If we need to postpone work, we will do it on the next day that conditions are favourable. We will do our best to keep you informed of any major changes.

Not long now until Christmas. I would like to take this opportunity to thank you all for supporting the KIDS WEST holiday program and would like to wish you and your families a very Merry Christmas and a Safe and Happy New Year.

We will NOT be running a program before Christmas as Elmgrove School finishes on Tuesday 19th December and we are getting new carpet laid in the hall at this time. There will be NO After School Care available on Tuesday 19th December.

Our 2024 Summer program will run from Monday 8th January until Friday 26th January 2024. Elmgrove School starts back on Tuesday 30th January 2024. There will be NO care available on Monday 29th January 2024.

Please note - Occasionally we have children booked into our program who fail to arrive on the day without any notification. This has caused some families to miss out especially on trip days. This has also cost the program, as we are required to provide correct staff to children ratios and pay for children booked on trips rather than those who actually attend. Failure to attend booked sessions in the holiday program that have not been notified by 8am on the day will incur a three hour charge as well as the cost of any trips booked on that day.

We have a fun-filled program planned. Please bring togs and towel everyday as we will have lots of water play, water fights and water games etc. Children are welcome to bring along bikes and scooters, please ensure they have their helmets and we hold no responsibility they get lost or damaged.

There will be an extra charge for each trip and that will be added on to your account. These charges can be found on the program.

Hot lunches will be available on days we are at school. Hot chips \$2.50, pie \$2.50, noodles \$1.50. These need to be ordered and paid (cash) for on the day.

Any change of program will be on the blackboard at the program and on our facebook page.
