Message from The Principal

Road works started outside the school yesterday and this is causing some difficulties for families dropping children to school. There is walking access to our front gate from both ends of the block and all traffic is being directed in a one way loop with access to the school carpark via Ayr Street and then out via Muir street. This is expected to be in place for the rest of the term. We will have an adult on duty at both the Ayr Street intersection and the Muir Street intersection in the morning and afternoon to ensure safe crossing of the children walking. If you are able to help with supervising these intersection either in the morning or after school please let the office know. This would be a great help to the staff.

Today our middle school are out on either the Rail trail or at the dinosaur park. This was such as success last year we have decided run it again. The children were very excited this morning loading onto the buses. Yesterday those children going on the rail trail had their bikes checked and did some bike skills with Constable Plew.

We have now completed the staff allocations for next year and class placements for our children. We have no changes in staff for 2024 but we do have a couple of teachers changing hubs. This information will come home on Friday the 15th December with school reports. Our transition morning for children to visit their new classes and spend some time with their new teachers is on Monday 18th December.

The Board of Trustees met on Tuesday night. This was the final board meeting for the term. It was a data heavy meeting with end of year data, intervention reports and the results from the latest set of PAT assessments. We evaluated our 2023 targets and discussed some very pleasing academic results. The next phase of the building project will start on Monday next week we will again have gated off areas of the playground as the builders start on the roof replacement and the next two bathroom blocks in the Juniors.

I would like to congratulate the fundraising team on a very successful Golf fundraiser where they raised \$13,000 a tremendous effort by a small group of dedicated parents.

We are currently selling tickets for the bus tour part of the Family Christmas Lights Bus Tour, which is on next Wednesday. This was run by the junior school last year but has been opened up to the whole school this year. We have a shared takeaway dinner, Christmas carols and the Bus tour for those who want to view the local lights. Tickets are \$2 each to contribute towards the cost of the buses. We have ordered buses to cater for 200 passengers so make sure you get tickets if you want to take part as you do need a ticket to ride.

The Dunedin City Council has contracted a package of School Safety Improvement work to Downer NZ Ltd.

You may be aware that the work involved at Elmgrove Primary School in Mosgiel includes a raised crossing at the school intersection improvements at the intersections of:

- Argyle Street and Mure Street
- Argyle Street and Ayr Street
- · Argyle Street and Lanark Street

Stage one at Argyle and Lanark Streets is nearing completion. The next stage will include the intersection of Argyle and Mure Streets and the intersection of Argyle and Ayr Streets.

We are writing to let you know that, subject to weather and other unforeseen circumstances, we will be starting Stage 2 approximately Wednesday 29th November.

Stage Two: This stage of work will include a road closure on Argyle Street from Mure Street to Ayr Street, one way traffic on parts of Ayr and Mure Streets and temporary speed restrictions. Detours will be marked with detour signage so that you can still reach your destination.

School traffic will have vehicle access to Elmgrove School heading towards Hall Street and turning left into the school grounds. All vehicles departing the school onto Ayr Street will need to turn left and follow the detour signs.

Public bus stops affected by detoured routes will have temporary locations during the work.

Some notes about the work are below:

Safety - As construction work can create multiple hazard areas, please be aware of the dangers posed by machinery and work sites. Whilst we endeavour to leave the site as tidy and user-friendly as possible, please also be aware that the work area may have uneven surfaces and take care if you need to cross the site. Should you notice anything of concern on our operational sites, I welcome your feedback.

Road closure - Downer will have temporary road closures, detours, speed restrictions and other traffic management measure sin place during the work. If access is required during working hours, please liaise constructively with staff on-site or contact me to arrange this. **Please be assured that mail and rubbish services will be accommodated**.

Access and Parking – Prior to work commencing, we will place no-parking cones in the area we would like left clear to enable our work to be carried out. Please keep your vehicles clear from this area. Vehicles within our work site restricting our ability to carry out the work safely may be shifted.

During construction access to some properties may be restricted. This can be a couple of days while we excavate old kerb & pour new kerb, usually 3 – 5 days. If you have any concerns regarding access, please talk to crew onsite who can advise and work to enable access when required.

Disruption - We understand construction works can cause major disruption. We will be doing all we can to minimise the impact on your household or business.

Communication - Please note that resurfacing and construction work can be subject to weather. If we need to postpone work, we will do it on the next day that conditions are favourable. We will do our best to keep you informed of any major changes.
