Message from The Principal

Kia ora

On Tuesday night, the Board had its first meeting for the year. We looked at the schools annual plan and discussed our targets for this year. Each year we set goals for student achievement, school performance, student and staff wellbeing, professional development and financial performance in order to monitor our success and progress throughout the year. This year, we have set our achievement reporting targets around junior reading and overall mathematics achievement in Year 5 and 6. The Board also finalised and signed off the Board Assurance documents for the Education Review Office who are undertaking a review of the school currently.

Our boiler replacement project is one step closer and all of the new heat pumps to be installed throughout the school have arrived. It is our expectation that these will be installed this term and then the cranes and heavy machinery should be on site during the next school holidays to remove our current boilers. The upgrade of the junior school toilets are at the design stage and should begin once building consent is approved. A couple of smaller maintenance projects included the replacement of the basketball hoops and the locks on the middle school toilet doors.

Today we had a mufti day to raise funds for School's badly affected by Cyclone Gabrielle. These funds will be combined with those raised by other Dunedin schools and sent away next week. We raised \$316.60 today.

I remind families that the Dunedin primary schools will be closing early on 1 March to allow staff to attend their NZEI union meeting and vote on the current government offer. This is Wednesday next week. Please arrange to collect children from school by 12.30pm




